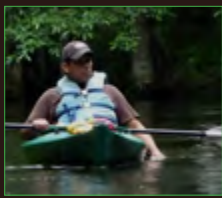

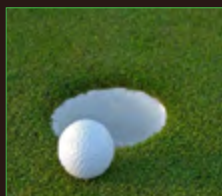

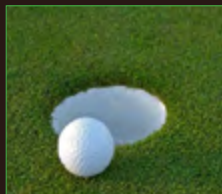

## Spring Means Golf in Scotland County

Our Scottish forbears weren't all work and no play. Along with their pipes and tartans, they brought their fascination with a little white ball and a bag full of clubs. But there's a reason why golf's American heritage is laden with images of the Sandhills region.

The early summer in Scotland County provides much the same inspiring scenery as our rather more well-known neighbor to the north – namely, verdant pine trees with an understory of azalea and dogwood. Against this backdrop, golf course designers have laid out challenging links to test your skills while you enjoy a game with your foursome on a Saturday.

### **Deercroft Golf and Country Club:**

Designed by Gardner Gilley, The "Deercroft" course features 6,566 yards from the long tees, with a par of 72. Golf Digest has described Deercroft as the "Best kept secret in the Pinehurst area" and golf advisor recently voted as having the friendliest staff in the country. ### **Cypress Creek Golf Links:**

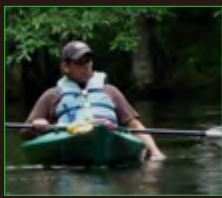

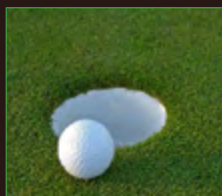

## Bike System Shows-off Scotland County

The Scotland County bicycle route system consists of three numbered, signed routes and several unsigned connectors. This 147-mile route system uses lightly traveled, paved roads favored by local bicyclists to link towns and points of interest as well as for peaceful rides through the countryside. The relatively flat terrain of Scotland County is ideal for cyclists of all abilities with only scattered small hills to add interest.



Whether you wish to take a short ride, an all-day trip, or a longer overnight tour, all the information you need to plan your ride is on a new, easy to use map. The complete Scotland County bicycle routes, highlighted on the map in different colors, consists of three signed routes totaling 114 miles and an additional 33 miles of unsigned connector routes. By combining these routes in different ways, you can create a variety of trip options.

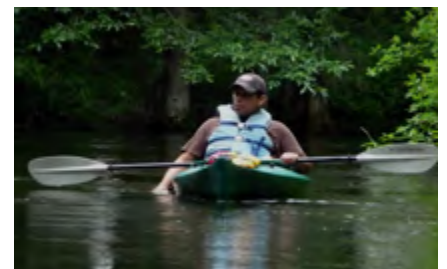

### The Wonder of the Lumber River

The Lumber River has been voted one of North Carolina's Ten Natural Wonders. In addition to being a "Natural Wonder," the Lumber River is the only North Carolina black water river to earn federal designation as a National Wild and Scenic River.

Access to the Chalk Banks State Park and the Lumber River are on highway 401, just north of Wagram. The park is open Thursdays through Sunday. If you are interested in exploring the river, give the Park Rangers a call and they will help you with your visit:

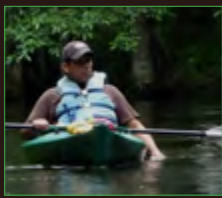

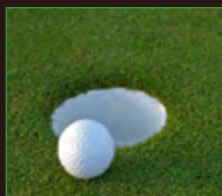
