Mud. Music. Something for everyone. That may not be the slogan for the 2018 Mud Bash, but it certainly could be.

Held at the OutBack ATV/MX park on McGirts Bridge Rd., the annual Mud Bash combines ATV/MX riding, live concerts, camping and friendship to create a one-of-a-kind weekend. The event is sponsored by the Outback Park and ATV Candy.

The Mud Bash weekend kicks-off on Thursday, April 5th as visitors and guests start coming to the park and Laurinburg. On Friday, they will have all-day riding and a concert featuring: Ray Gotti, Da Pigpen, Big Murph, and Cypress Spring.

Saturday's highlights include Mud Races, a 50/50 Hole, Truck Pit, and over \$1,500 in Cash Prizes. Then Saturday night the park will have a second concert with Amber DeLaCruz, Big Chuck, Nu Breed with Walt Lamb, and Mocassin Creek.

The cost for the weekend is \$40 and patrons can come and go as they please – each day. One costs covers the entire weekend. There is plenty of space for camping, RV's are welcome (must use generator for power), and everyone is welcome to use their fill station for water needs. Laurinburg hotels are also ready to host visitors. The ATV park will provide overnight security for your machine, so you can head to the hotels knowing your ride is safe.

The Outback Motorsports Complex is a 700-acre facility located in Scotland County. The facility provides freshly cut trails as well as a mud pit that is 200 foot-long and 30 feet wide that will be the highlight of the weekend riding.
