Originally founded in 1989 as a celebration of the 250th anniversary of the coming of the first group of Highland Scots to North Carolina, the "Scottish Heritage Symposium" provides an unparalleled opportunity for persons interested in Scottish and Scottish-American history and culture to learn from top scholars in their fields. This year's symposium will be held March 5 - 7.

Equestrian

St. Andrews University features one of the premier collegiate equestrian centers in the country. Consequently, we are fortunate to host many of the marquee college events.

The season gets started with an IDA (Intercollegiate Dressage Association) Show on February 2nd. Dressage is a sport involving the execution of precise movements by a trained horse in response to barely perceptible signals from its rider. Particularly important are the animal's pace and bearing in performing walks, trots, canters, and more specialized maneuvers.

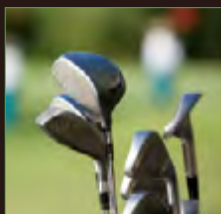

Spring Means Golf in Scotland County

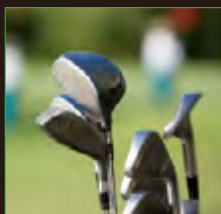

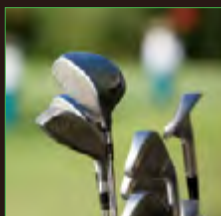

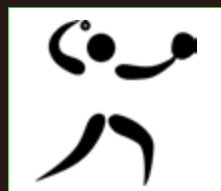
